1. Pronoun set I are nominative enclitic pronouns which attach to subject focus verbs.
2. Pronoun set II are genitive enclitic pronouns which attach to nonsubject focus verbs. Pronoun set II are also possessor pronouns.
3. Pronoun set III are nominative free-standing pronouns that replace focus noun phrases.
4. Pronoun set IV are nominative free-standing pronouns that replace focus noun phrases. The occurrence of set IV pronouns is less common than set III pronouns, but the exact function of set IV pronouns has not yet been determined.
5. Alternate forms -k and -m of pronoun set II attach to words ending in vowels. Forms -ku and -nu attach to words ending in consonants. (See Appendix D for a morphophonemic rule about the addition of pronoun set II to verbs with -on and -an suffixes.)
