






If you do not finish all your treatment, the bacteria become strong, so next time you take medicine for TB it may not work well.



If you finish all six months of TB medicine faithfully, you will become well again, and you will not pass it on to others.

Tibi na'uro vededeai?

What causes TB?



TiBi vipa kekei ni berui goroi ta opiouti vadio kaumo. Idomai hi'ai ta eve'ai modoboi haka.

TB are tiny bacteria (tiny germs) which live in the lungs.

Nu kavaia ro ovoroho ka, ubi amiai ro ure ema'oi tara, e asimanai ta ra, e vade aradu'uti tara.



It is spread to other people by coughing,
6 sneezing, and talking.

Ure ipi imouti behai memiho ka.

Koikohotu ra nu'a paha paipai da ma imo'ai, ka mukoi ta ivatoviao.

No spitting on the ground! Everyone must spit onto a leaf and then burn it.



Hunui agesi ra hipurai ta ma oromurai, urei ema'o ta'ui.


Wearing a mask stops TB spreading.

How do we stop TB spreading?


**TiBi gimo i kehiboi ta tauha ma-o'ui,
muramura idioi. Mabu roro gimo i omoti
ava'ai ra, gimo i huna i'i ta, roro amia
ubi eito ima'ati modobo ka. Moto ga'u

It is most important that anyone with TB comes to hospital for treatment **EARLY** before they get too sick and pass their sickness to others. Bring the whole family to be checked.

Ubi amiai ro eidai hovihovi hi'a ka berui eito, ka amia vati tamai goroi ta.

Other people may then get TB in their lungs, or in any other part of their body.


TB is not caused by custom or sorcery! 7

TiBi odau gamo'o atai, nia-namu moto ga'u niroi ta emidioi. Moto niro meari hobobo tuaha. Gimo rautu merei ro modobo ka amiai ima'ati.



TB is spread easily when lots of people live and sleep together in crowded houses without open windows. Many people in these families get sick.

Tibi gimo i odai a'ai haka ubi amiai ne'eito, ni irobuti vati meari hoboboi re ka auo-uo.



TB is not spread so easily when people live and sleep in spacious houses with the windows open. These houses keep families healthy!
