A. House Building in Nepal (DN-15)

Durga was very impressed when he watched some houses being built at Kirtipur in Kathmandu, Nepal.¹ He describes the process in some detail in this text.

A.1 Free Translation of Text

1. *This is about house building in Kirtipur (in Kathmandu).*
2. *When building a house, people will first dig up the soil to a certain depth. And there they will thoroughly mix together gravel and cement. And later they will lay the bricks and sandy cement together. They will put scaffolding of iron in place down below first.*
3. *And when it's really high, they will make a hod for taking the bricks and cement up.*
4. *When one storey is finished they will put up iron poles otherwise wooden planks and from below they will place the boards carefully in the holes. And from one side they covered with blue metal.*
5. *And later they raised (the building) a little bit more (and) they made something like an **ak'hana** on one side. And at middle height they made two storeys. And they lifted and put in place the roof beam and they put in place the rafters fairly far apart and they nailed on the roof cross-pieces fairly far apart. And up above they covered it with beautifully made boards. Above that they roofed with tiles.*
6. *On one side there is a house. On one storey up above is something like a threshing floor. And just a little distance (from there) they built a waist high dog kennel.*
7. *And on the top floor they made two rooms, one small and the other big. They will sleep in the big one and they have placed the baggage in the small one.*
8. *And below are three rooms. In one room they will do work (an office) and in one room they will prepare food and where there is a small porch like place is the place for people to sit.*
9. *People will call that house a two storey house.*
10. *Also for the windows, for the screens, (they made) beautiful wood, they hammered in shaped sticks and they have added the screens.*
11. *On two sides there are stairs.*
12. *It is high in the middle. On one side is a stair.*
13. *They built the Kirtipur houses like this.*
14. *The time of raising the walls, they built very small on two sides and they made it very high in the middle. One side they raised just a little high. Where they will sleep, they made that room medium height. And they made stairs on one side.*
15. *They roofed with tiles after having covered with boards.*
16. *In the room where they will sit they have made a fireplace for warming themselves. And in winter the fire will warm (them).*
17. *The Kirtipur houses are just like that.*
